All of this analysis, as previously stated, must be supported by appropriate evidence from the text.

Remember to:

- Utilise a clearly defined essay structure (S.E.X.Y being the recognised method here at MAC)
- Quote weave in your work for maximum sophistication
- Avoid plot-retelling and ensure you actually analyse elements of the statement alongside the text's components
- Utilise appropriate and academic language in your analysis
- Address the author's intention and reader's response
